Dear Members,

The Victorian Illawarra Calf Day is being planned for Monday 30th March at the Kyabram Showgrounds. The Victorian Branch operates under the umbrella of the Illawarra Cattle Society of Australia, and is therefore subject to the rules and regulations of the National body.

For those of you who aren't aware, there were some changes to the breed's showing policy that took effect on the 1st of January 2015 – and so these will apply to this year's calf day. The revised policy is as follows:

To be eligible to be shown, animals born after 1/1/2012 must be:

- **Minimum 37.5% Illawarra** (as printed on registration certificate)
- **Both parents must be registered in the ICSA herd book or be of breed that has full reciprocal rights with the ICSA** (i.e. Milking Shorthorn breeds from USA, UK, Canada & NZ)
- **Existing colour rule applies:** *i.e. they must be red, white, roan, or red & white – including the various shades of red. Minimal black hair around the edges of ears and muzzle are accepted. Excluded will be black faced and black or brindle colours.*
